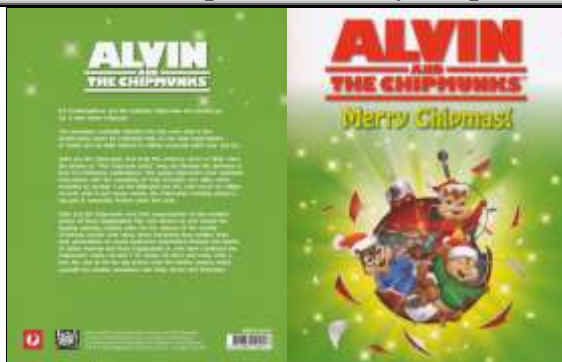

Live was not meant to be easy and for stamp designers mistake do happen as was the case for the first Guernsey Bailiwick stamps issued on 1 October 1969 (not quite the dark ages for most Europeans).



The location is 40°30'N
 This occurred for the 1p and for the 1/6p stamps.

The correct location is 49° 30'N. Both stamps were reprinted and reissued on 12 December 1969 and 2 April 1970 respectively.

King George did use reading glasses and the following stamps does show him wearing them.



Well, and then he lost them:



For those accurate people not an easy thing to swallow when the dot over the 'c' disappears, as can be seen for the lower values.



Information received, indicates that this happened on two stamps per sheet.
