Please note the little blue dot (c1/R4) on the number 7 issue. Those collectors are lucky who got an example. Who knows how much they will cost in a decade.

I have had to endue another operation on my right eye. If this keeps going I will be fully repaired but may have to get a job to afford buying stamps at the same volume as I did over the last decade.

I like to thank Richard for his patience with me documenting postmarks of NSW. A volume of over 80 pages is quite a task but now done.

St George Society 1958


For the 21st anniversary of the St George Philatelic Society, Rockdale, new South Wales a stamp exhibition was held on the 11th October 1958 at the Palais-Grande, Rockdale.



A souvenir sheet was issued. The sheet shows the Society Logo with a 21st Anniversary Key thrown in. The sheet was printed in five different colours: red (scarce), blue, green, mauve and brown. Sheets have been cut to form mixed sets.

St. George Society1967

To commemorate their 30th anniversary the St. George Philatelic Society held a on the 18th and 19th November 1967 a stamp exhibition at Coronation Hall, Arncliffe, New South Wales.



A souvenir sheet designed by E. J. Gawthorne (a member of the society) was issued. The quantity was limited to 1000 sheets. Two cachets inverted printed in blue and red and brown and green respectively can be found on the sheet.


The St George philatelic Society held an exhibition from 28th to 29th October 1972 and to commemorate the event used machine cancels.




A stunning reproduction of the 1937 and 1938 stamp issue of King George VI under the Societies Coat of Arms is the third of a series of seven to be issued annually.



The 6th card shows King George VI in his Coronation Robes using the 10 shilling stamp.


St. George Society 1987



The 7th card was the last in this series to fiancé GEORGEPEX 87. The exhibition was staged at the A. J. Clark Centre, Kenwyn Street, Hurstville.

A souvenir card was issued by a dealer during the show.





300 of these cards had a 2c Antarctic Territory stamp attached at the right hand and tied by a special GEORGEPEX postmarker. Many were given away during the show to customers. Another 150 were similarly marked with a postmark of 30th May. Another 50 had a second day's postmarker. A further 400 had a label (Collect / Stamps / It's Fun!) affixed.

STAMPEX 86 was the first international philatelic exhibition held in Adelaide. It was supported by F.I.A.P. and the F.I.P., the Australian Philatelic Federation and its State Councils, the South Australian Philatelic Association In., philatelic societies throughout Australia, the Australasian Stamp Dealers Association, the International Federation of Stamp Dealers Association and Australia Post.

Mail was carried by Mounted Police. Separate envelopes were issued.

Avon Graphics

Avon Graphics produced an intaglio printed card produced at the exhibition featuring a reproduction of the first Postmaster of the Colony of South Australia Mr Thomas Gilbert. Mr Gilbert was appointed 10th April 1837. The card measured 146 mm x 262 mm (when fully opened but folded twice) using Curtis Smooth Bridgewater 218 gsm paper. Production was 9300 cards sold at \$1.00 each. The working display was controlled by the printer Mr. Thomas Voce.
