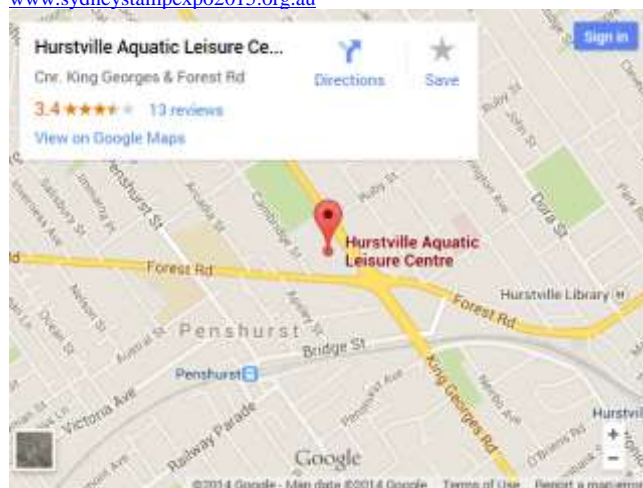

I do not want to bore you with the number of prestige covers; Medallion covers, sheetlets, different self-adhesive sheets, gutter 10 & 20, maxi cards, stamp packs, facsimile letters, war remembrance collectables, sheetlets to celebrate various things like Blinky Bill and Nutsy, ARL & NRL sheets and booklets, sheet for Planes, Bat Man, etc. Ah, I nearly forgot: You can have an image of yourself or friend or relative on a label next to a stamp. Very collectable!

By the way, the first four fantastically wrapped sheets making money for Australia Post are issued in January and February 2015.
